Junior Ice Hockey - Parental Involvement

The South Australian Ice Hockey Association is a non-for-profit organisation with all tasks carried out by dedicated volunteers. Thus, we ask all parents to play a part in helping to run it.

Many parents are keen to be involved but often don't know what they can do or who to ask to become more involved.

Tasks parents can assist with include (but are not limited to):

- Assisting with fundraising by donating goods to sell at our stalls and/or manning the stall
- Helping to bring necessary equipment to and from the store room
- Helping to tie skates
- Manning (opening and closing) bench gates during games (with coach permission)
- Learning how to score games
- Learning how to run the time clock
- Learning how to run the music for games
- Recording times during skills testing
- Assisting coaches during off-ice trainings
- Undertaking officials courses to become a coach or referee
- Volunteering your professional knowledge and skills i.e., medical, diet and nutrition, sporting, building etc
- Managing house league and representative teams

For some roles volunteers are required to have a Police Clearance and to be a minimum of an Associate Member of the South Australian Ice Hockey Association. Parents are strongly encouraged to register as volunteers with Ice Hockey Australia.
